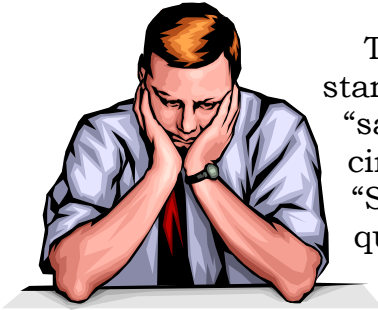


# Personal Satisfaction Inventory
